Turkish Figs—The first Turkish figs for  
this season came in yesterday; several  
of the wholesalers having shipments from  
Smyrna. They are of choice quality,  
but very high priced, as quoted below.

Dates—Hallow dates also made  
their first appearance for this season,  
and they too, are of choice quality,  
selling at 20c per lb.

Celery advanced in price, large cases of  
the "redwood" variety selling at \$6.50 per  
case. This is caused by the demand being  
greater than the supply, as the local  
production is just about used up and the  
California is not ready yet.
