

CHARGED WITH PERJURY.

Toronto Woman Arrested—The Alleged Offense Was Committed in Detroit—Story of Fire and Insurance.

Mrs. Ellen Gertrude Bolger, wife of Joseph Bolger, 46 Van Ness-street, is charged with perjury committed in Detroit. On April 13 a fire occurred in the millinery store of Mrs. Nellie Morse, at the corner of Port-street, Detroit. This made the third or fourth time this property had been burned out. In this last case the insurance had only been placed on Friday, and the fire occurred the following Monday. This roused the suspicion of the authorities, and an examination of the premises was made by the police. The fire was caused by the plaster of the ceiling falling and upsetting a small oil stove, and that there was a woman in the store at the time, and that two men came in and extinguished the fire. The police questioned Mrs. Morse pretty closely, and she was charged with incendiarism, and the result was that an advertisement appeared in a daily paper, asking the woman and the two men who saw the fire to apply at a certain address.

The examination was fixed for May 6. On that date the woman who was supposed to have been in the store when the fire occurred appeared as a witness for the defense. She said she did not know Mrs. Morse, and that she saw the fire start as Mrs. Morse stated. The witness gave her name as Annie Gray.

Detective Baker of the Detroit force, who was working on the case, ascertained that this woman is a sister-in-law of Mrs. Morse, and it is claimed was paid \$500 for giving her evidence. He located her in Toronto, and with the assistance of Detective Porter, the arrest was made yesterday.

Mrs. Bolger, who is the Miss Gray who gave the evidence, has not yet decided whether she will fight extradition or not.

RAINS IN MISSOURI.

The Ohio River is on a Rampage and Will Likely Do Great Damage at St. Louis.

St. Louis, Mo., May 22.—The Mississippi River is now within three feet of the danger line in front of this city. It is expected that the danger line will be reached by to-morrow night, and serious damage will result to property along the levee. Already property owners and storekeepers are moving their effects to upper floors. Advice received from Upper Missouri, Illinois and Iowa points state that all the rivers in those sections are on the rampage and pouring an immense volume of water into the Mississippi.

Throughout Missouri there is no cessation to the downpour of rain, which has continued almost without let-up since last Sunday. The rainfall so far exceeds 12 inches. There is no indication that the deluge is near an end. Every river, creek and tributary in the State is overflowing, and in some places the water covers the ground to a depth of two or three feet for a radius of a dozen miles.

In some places the rain is accompanied by terrific thunderstorms. Lightning struck the dome of the Capitol at Jefferson City, and the fire department extinguished the blaze with but little damage.
