LIVERPOOL CABLES EASIER,

But Chicago Options Rose Nearly a Cent.

The lower cables and large Northwest receipts this morning caused a weak feeling to pervade the Chicago wheat market. Later, however, good clearances, a fair export demand and an advance in cash prices at Minneapolis and St. Louis improved the situation, this month's delivery rising 1/4c, the December option 3/4c, and the May option 1/2c per bushel over yesterday's final figures. The close was at top prices of the day.

On the Liverpool board to-day, this month's wheat delivery eased off 3/4d, the December option 3/4d, and the March option 1/2d per cent. Spot wheat was 1/4d higher for the day.

Paris wheat closed 5 centimes lower to 4 centimes higher to-day. Antwerp wheat rose 25 centimes.

Chicago corn advanced 1/4c per bushel to-day. On the Liverpool board to-day, maize advanced 1/4c per cent, and futures 3/4d to 1/2d.

Chicago provisions advanced to-day in sympathy with grain.

Peas advanced 1/4d at Liverpool.

December wheat puts at Chicago, 67 1/2c; calls, 67c; Corn puts, 32 1/2c; calls, 32c.

United States Government crop report suggests a corn yield of 1,570,000 bushels; oats, 765,000 bushels.

Broomchests cables: Carriage firm at 3d advance. On Odessa correspondent cables they are having further raises. Arrivals from Interior Limited. Arrivals at Theodosia, in the Crimea, insufficient to load steamers.

Total clearances to-day: Wheat and flour, 465,000 bushels; corn, 348,353 bushels.

Exports at New York to-day: Flour, 150,568 barrels and 6889 sacks; wheat, 113,230 bushels.

Primary wheat receipts to-day, 2,016,844 bushels, against 1,319,600 bushels the corresponding day of 1897.

Wheat receipts at Minneapolis and Duluth to-day, 1788 cars, against 1206 the same day a year ago.
