DEATH BY AN ACCIDENT.

The witnesses examined were Foreman Elgie, Chief Rogers, William McGee and Inspector Coppin.

The jury returned a verdict of accidental death, but added that the derick which the deceased was operating was placed on a scaffold insufficient for its support.

H. H. Dewar, appeared for the Crown, R. W. P. Parker for relatives of deceased. Coroner Fowell conducted the investigation.
