PAN-GERMAN CROWD NEAR PANIC THROUGH WAR STATEMENTS OF WILSON AND GEORGE

Fear Appeals to the German Masses Will Mobilize People in Demand for Peace.

The Hague, Jan. 9.—The Pan-German element in Germany, according to definite reports today, is showing signs of panic at the tactics of Lloyd George and President Wilson in appealing to the German masses will finally mobilize into a definite demand by Germany's people for immediate peace.

It is second-hand Reichstag majority will now hold firmly together, it having become a necessity for the majority parties to adhere to the strong position announced by the Reichstag, who on Monday's Vorparlament reaffirmed, absolutely oppose annexations in any form.

Chancellor von Hertling will probably resist the majority to a reply to Lloyd George, if any is made, but as the majority can dictate the substance of the reply, but not the form, the outlook is not optimistic on this score, as Hertling always emphasizes the strength of Germany, thus offsetting any moderate tendencies he may express.

Some Concessions Likely.

There now seems some possibility that the German Government may indicate concessions in the shape of arousing the opposition parties among the various Reichstag governments, fearing that these opposing elements in the case of any further German defiance, will induce a war to a finish.

Prominent writers in several of the important German newspapers are demanding that Foreign Minister Kuehlmann now offer some evidence of constructive statesmanship, based on the moderate tone of the Lloyd George appeal.

The question of all power is being keenly worked in Germany, and in many quarters here the talk of a great trust against the west front is taken as a means of keeping up the spirits of the people until an advantageous peace can be made. Democratic ideals, it is felt sure, are setting a firm hold in Germany and it seems to be only a matter of time when the people will compel the militarists to give way.

Winnipeg, Jan. 9.—A New York special to the Manitoba Free Press states that a Times dispatch from Amsterdam says that Germany is on the verge of a catastrophe worse than Russia's, and declares that Russia is on the verge of utter collapse.

A special cable to the same paper, dated from Paris, says the German chancellor, von Hertling, has announced that the following German peace terms, according to a Zurich dispatch, printed in the Matin today, quoting the Berlin Telegram, are:

"1.—Establishment of an international tribunal for future arbitration between nations and to provide for disarmament.

"2.—The occupied territory of Turkey to be respected.

"3.—Belgium to be restored on a basis of constitutional autonomy.

"4.—The occupied department of Northern France to be given the right of self-determination on the question of restoration."

600 APPEALS IN THIS DISTRICT NOT PASSED ON

Judges Have Big Task Still Ahead of Them on the Exemption Claims.

Out of 3,500 appeals filed with Deputy Registrar of Ontario, 600 appeals against the decisions of tribunals in this military district 2,500 have been passed on by the court, and 2,900 are still pending.

The remaining 2,900 appeals are in the district, and 600 appeals are to be allotted to the judges by the deputy registrar.

It is expected that it will take until the end of the month to pass on the cases are finally decided by the judges. Judge Talbot Macbeth disposed of 434 cases in which the appellants are yet pending. Over 200 of these appeals were filed by men resident in the city of Toronto.
