I642I Ottawa Febra 23,1909 Sir,-I beg to inform you that the Band of Indianatown the Thunderchild Indian Reserves Nos. II5 and IISA, situated North-west of Battleford, has surrendered the said reserves on certain conditions. One of these conditions is that in connection with a new reserve which isato be given them at Bright Sand Lake they are to have fishing privileges on some lake they may choose in the neighborhood of their new reserve. Bright Sand Lake is situated in Townships 53 and 54 Range 20 W.3.M. I shall be obliged if you will be good enough to direct that no fishing privileges are to be given to anyone in the said Bright Sand Lake in Turtle Lake, or in any other lakes in that vicinity until the Indians have selected the lake in which they desire the said privileges. When they have made the selection your Department will be communicated with to ascertain on what terms the fishing reserve privilege may be secured for the Indians.
