

PLOYERS AND WORK-PEOPLE

Short Title.

This act may be cited as the Free Public Labor Bureaux Act.

Interpretation

In this act, unless the context otherwise requires—

(a) Minister, means the Minister of Labor.

(b) Office, means the Free Public Labor Bureaux system.

Office

1.—There shall be a permanent office established, under the minister of labor, to be called the Free Public Labor Bureaux Department, for the purpose of establishing and maintaining a Central Labor Bureau and Local Free Public Labor Bureaux.

The minister of labor may operate and maintain them according to regulations laid down by the governor-in-council, and may also co-operate with other authorities maintaining Free Public Labor Bureaux.

2.—The governor-in-council may appoint such officers, subordinate officers,
