ECLIPSES FOR THE YEAR 1896.

During this year there will be two eclipses, both of the Sun.

I.—An annular eclipse of the Sun, February 1st, visible at Montreal as a partial eclipse at Sun Set.

II.—An annular eclipse of the Sun July 29th, visible at Montreal and over Canada as a partial eclipse. Central eclipse begins 9h. 9m. morning; Central eclipse at noon 11h. 5m. morning; Central eclipse ends 0h. 55m. evening, Montreal mean time.
