

non-union men. "I am opposed to that," Mr. Taft said. "It is harsh. Men should not be compelled to do that which they would not do if they were left free."

Mr. Harding said there must be a keynote and suggested a phrase of the chairman. "A canvass for the benefit of the boys," Mr. Terry said the questionaire was similar to the one used in Regina.

Mr. Taft told the audience that when the members of a labor union threaten the life of a community by means of a strike, threatens to make the public do without some of the necessities of life, if their employers do not pay them what they want, they cease to be a labor union and become a soviet, and," said the speaker, "they are introducing Bolshevism. The right to strike is conceded, so far as to say to the public that they are going to endanger the life of the only protect a legal right.
