REVALUATION BY MEXICO.

Heavy Duty to be Placed on American Cattle, Sheep, Swine, Etc.

CITY OF MEXICO, via GAZETTE, TEX., Sept. 7.—An important change in the tariff, which will seriously affect the growing trade in the importation of American cattle, sheep and swine, has been decreed. Formerly cattle, etc., came in free duty, but since the American government entered on the policy of shutting out Mexican silver, lead and ironing duties on Mexican vessels, there has been a popular demand, even among journals and politicians friendly to the United States, that this government should place duties on American cattle, sheep and swine, and the result is that from Nov. 1 next cattle will pay \$3 head, sheep 25 cents, pigs \$2.25, mules \$2, each, horses except geldings, \$30, and fresh meat, hitherto free, 10 cents a kilogram, or about five cents a pound. This decree is a severe blow to the growing cattle and sheep trade with the United States, and will be felt by the railways, which have spent much money preparing for increasing business, but even among resident Americans it is acknowledged that the government must show a disposition to maintain the rights of Mexican citizens, whose interests in Mexico have been harmed enormously by Secretary Windom's decision regarding the Mexican lead ores. In some northern states there is a crisis among miners in consequence of an unexpected falling in the price of lead. The American government has taken up this matter and put a stop to the policy of Mr. Windom, who in playing directly into the hands of the Mexican cattle interests here, by creating a feeling that Americans do not desire trade on fair terms with Mexico.
