DISASTERS.

London, Dec. 7.—Stmr Russia (Rus), Zerpe, from Libau Nov. 25 for New York, is anchored near Lysell with machinery out of order. A telegram received from St. Thomas as states that stmr Craigina (Br), Mc-Glashan, from Buenos Ayres, etc., for New York, has put in there leaky. Temporary repairs can be made there without the cargo being discharged.

A despatch from Avonmouth, Eng., lays: Captain Hugh Roberts and two members of the crew of the British wild Evelyn, which was wrecked in indecean, were rescued by the teamer Monmouth, which arrived pecember 5 from Montreal. Other members of the crew of the Evelyn were saved by the British collier Inversel.

MONTFORT ARRIVES.

After a favorable voyage from Antwerp via London the C. P. R. steamer Montfort arrived in port yesterday morning and docked at Sand Point about eleven o'clock. The voyage was made in ten days and some fog was encountered as the ship neared this side of the Atlantic. The ship brought 4,530 tons of general cargo and 160 steerage passengers, the latter going west yesterday afternoon.

THE FIRST SHIPMENT.

The first manifest filed at the Custom House in connection with the transatiantic shipments is that of the C. P. R. Line S. S. Montreal, bound for London. She took away Canadian goods valued at \$242,259, and foreign goods valued at \$58,257, making a total of \$300,516. Among her shipments were 14,600 sacks of Canadian flour and 6,900 sacks of foreign flour. Her wheat shipments were 200,000 bushels.
