SCENE OF THE DISASTROUS TURKISH DEFEAT BY RUSSIANS IN THE CAUCASUS.

The Turkish invasion of Russia in the Caucasus is apparently at an end. The disastrous defeat of the Turks at Sari Kamysh and Ardahan has ended the movement of Euver Pacha toward Tiflis. The Turkish project was to hold the Russians with a portion of the army, while the remainder was to envelop the Russian right flank, cut off the Russians fighting south of Sari Kamysh and Kars, then occupy Ardahan and advance against the front from Atchaltsich and Achalkalacht, threatening Tiflis and Kutais. The Turks have now been rolled back to the frontier. Their invasion of Persia near Urumiah has called forth an ultimatum and Persia now threatens to enter the war.


