Boys from Dominion Get Upper Hand of German Gunners on Western Front.

(By Stewart Lyon, special Canadian Press correspondent in France.) Canadian Army Headquarters, July 27.—Our guns have at last definitely secured the upper hand on this part of the Western front. The artillery actions by which this has been done have been in progress for several days. With the object of challenging our ascendancy in guns, the enemy recently brought up a battery of artillery attached to a Prussian Guard division. These additional gunners were given practically unlimited supplies of ammunition, which they used for the bombardment of our heavy artillery positions. They were good men and a duel took place between them and our guns in the Loos and Avion sectors. It has ceased now. The battery work of the British and Canadian gunners proved too much along for the highly trained artillerists of the Prussian Guard and their activity is now subnormal.
