Has been a School Commr. and a Municipal Councillor, and is now Mayor of Stellarton. First returned to Ho. of Assem. at g. e., 1890. A Liberal-Conservative.—*Stellarton, N.S.*

HUNT, RICHARD. (*Queen's*).

Merchant. First returned to House of Assembly at g. e., 1890. A Liberal.—*Brookfield (Queen's), N.S.*

JAMIESON, J. H. (*Inverness*).

Is a Barrister. First returned to Ho. of Assem. at g. e., 1894.—*Port Hood, N.S.*

JOHNSTON, Hon. THOMAS (*Shelburne*).

Grandf. came from Scot. S. of Thomas Johnston, Esq. B. at Shelburne, N.S., 30 Oct., 1821. Ed. there. M., 1866, Jerusha, relict of the late Capt. R. D. Todd. Is a merchant and shipowner. Was Sheriff of Shelburne for seven years. Sworn of the Ex. Council, 3 Aug., 1882. First returned to House of Assem. for present seat by acclamation at g. e., 1867; re-elected at g. e., 1871; by acclamation at g. e., 1874; and re-elected at g. e., 1882, 1886, 1890 and 1894. JOYCE, SIMON (*Richmond*).

Is a school teacher. First returned to Ho. of Assem. at g. e., 1894.—*D'Escouse*.

LAW, WILLIAM (*Yarmouth*).

B. in Belfast, Irel., 5 Aug., 1833. Came to Yarmouth, N.S., Oct., 1847, and remained there two years, when he removed to Oxford, Mass., where he remained until 1855, and
