And be it enacted, That in case the proprietor of such Township, lot, half lot or parcel of land, shall not reside in the District in which such Township, lot, half lot or parcel of land shall lie, the writ of summons may 10 be validly served on his agent or attorney, or if he have no such agent, then by leaving a copy thereof for him at the County Registry Office addressed to him as the proprietor of a certain lot or parcel of land, describing it, but without naming him. 15
