CHAP. 8.

An Act to amend and consolidate the Acts relating to the Superannuation of persons employed in the Civil Service of Canada.

[Assented to 25th May, 1883.]

ER Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Presmble. Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows :-

- 1. The Civil Service for the purposes of this Act shall in- who to be deemed civil clude and consist of-
- 1. All officers, clerks and employés in or under the several Those to whom 45 V. Departments of the Executive Government who are paid a c. 4, applies. yearly salary, and to whom " The Canada Civil Service Act, 1882," applies, and those who in case they were or are appointed after the coming into force of that Act were or are appointed in conformity with its provisions;

2. All such officers, clerks and employes of the second or certain peroutside division of the Civil Service, to whom "The Canada sons in the outside ser-Civil Service Act, 1882," does not apply, and who are employed vice. in an established capacity, and paid a yearly salary as the Governor in Council may, from time to time, designate;

3. The permanent officers and servants of the Senate and Officers and House of Commons, and the permanent officers and servants Senate and employed in the Library of Parliament, who for the purposes of this Act shall be held to be in the Civil Service of Canada, saving always all legal rights and privileges of either House as respects the appointment or removal of its officers and servants or any of them;

4. All persons now contributing to the Superannuation Present contributors to Fund:
