XII. And he it further enasted, That the Lords Commissioners of the Treasurp, or Lord Digh Treasurer for the Time being, are hereby authorised and required to iffue and cause to be paid all such Sums of Woney, not exceeding Four thousand Pounds, to such Person 02 Persons as the said Commissioners, or any Two or more of them, thall, by Writing under their Bands, desire or direct, out of any Part of the publick Monies remaining in his Wajedp's Erchequer; which Sum fo iffued and paid, thall be employed for the Payment of Clerks. Wellengers, and other Officers, and in defraying all other necessary Charges in or about the Execution of the Powers of this Ad, and in such Wanner, and in fuch Proportions, as thall be appointed by the faid Commissioners, or any Two or more of them, by Mrit= ing under their Pands and Seals in that Behalf, the same to be accounted for by the Person or Persons to whom the same thall be issued and paid, according to the Course of His Wajelly's Erchequer, without any Fee or other Charges to be taken or demanded for the issuing and Payment of the same, or on the passing of the faid Accounts, other than such Sum as the said Commillioners, or any Two or more of them, thall appoint; and which Honey so issued thall not be subject to any Tax, Duty, Rate, or Allellment whatsoever, imposed by Authority of Parliament.

XIII. Provided always, and be it enasted, That any of the said Commissioners being on Half Pay, as an Officer of the Wavy or Army, shall be intitled to receive such Half Pay, notwithstanding any Compensation that may be made to him soz executing the Powers of this Ad, on his taking the following Dath before the Governor or Lieutenant Governor of any of his Pajesty's Colonies or Plantations in America, or before some Justice of the Peace, who is hereby impowered to administer the same:
