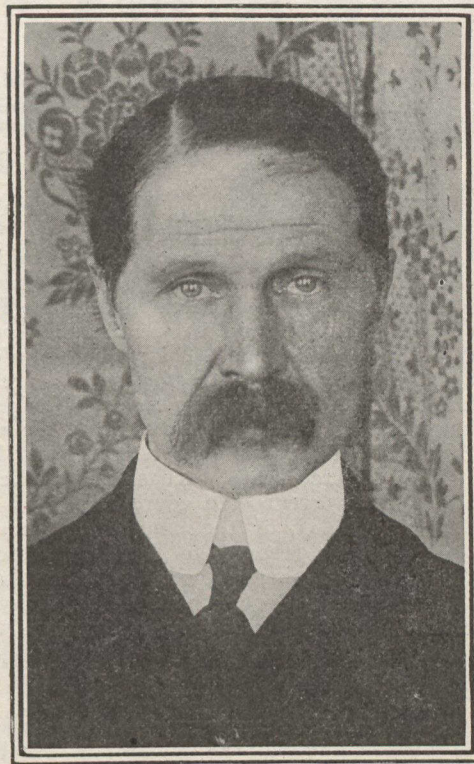

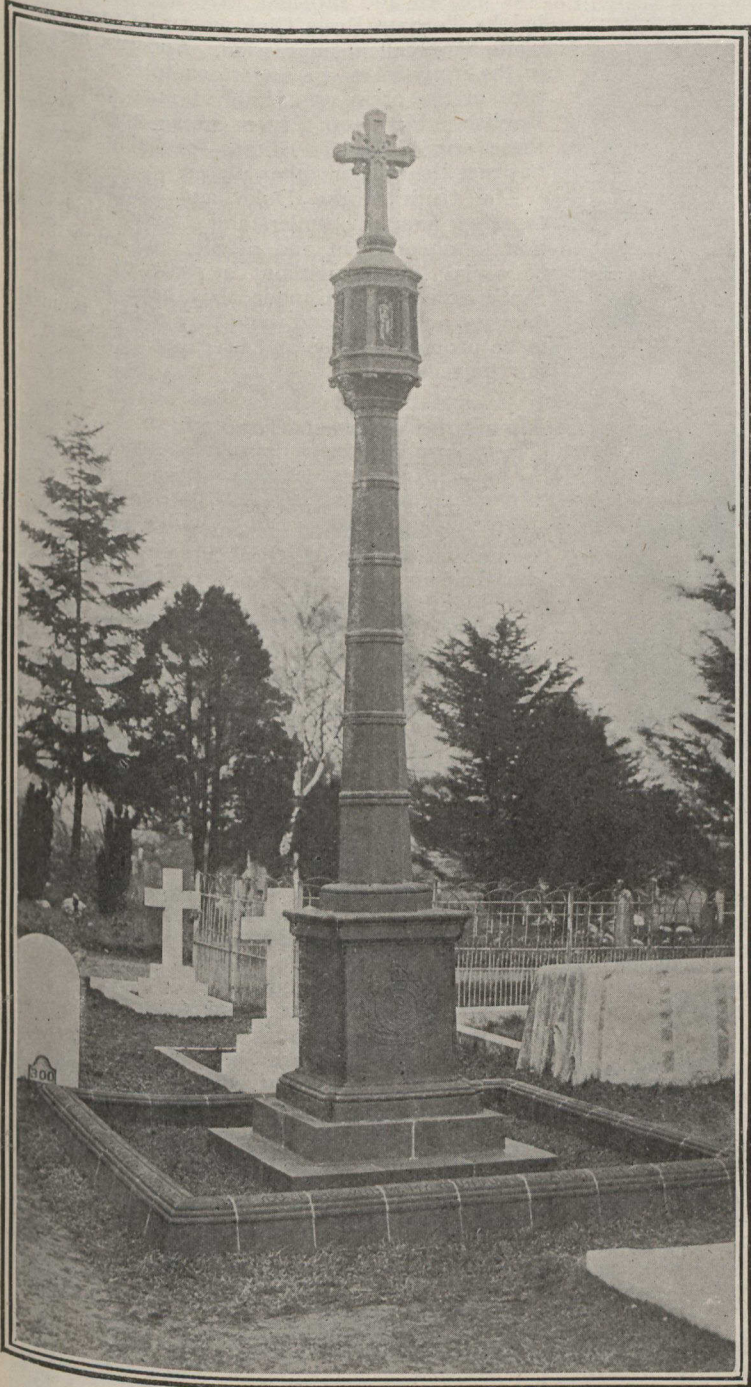

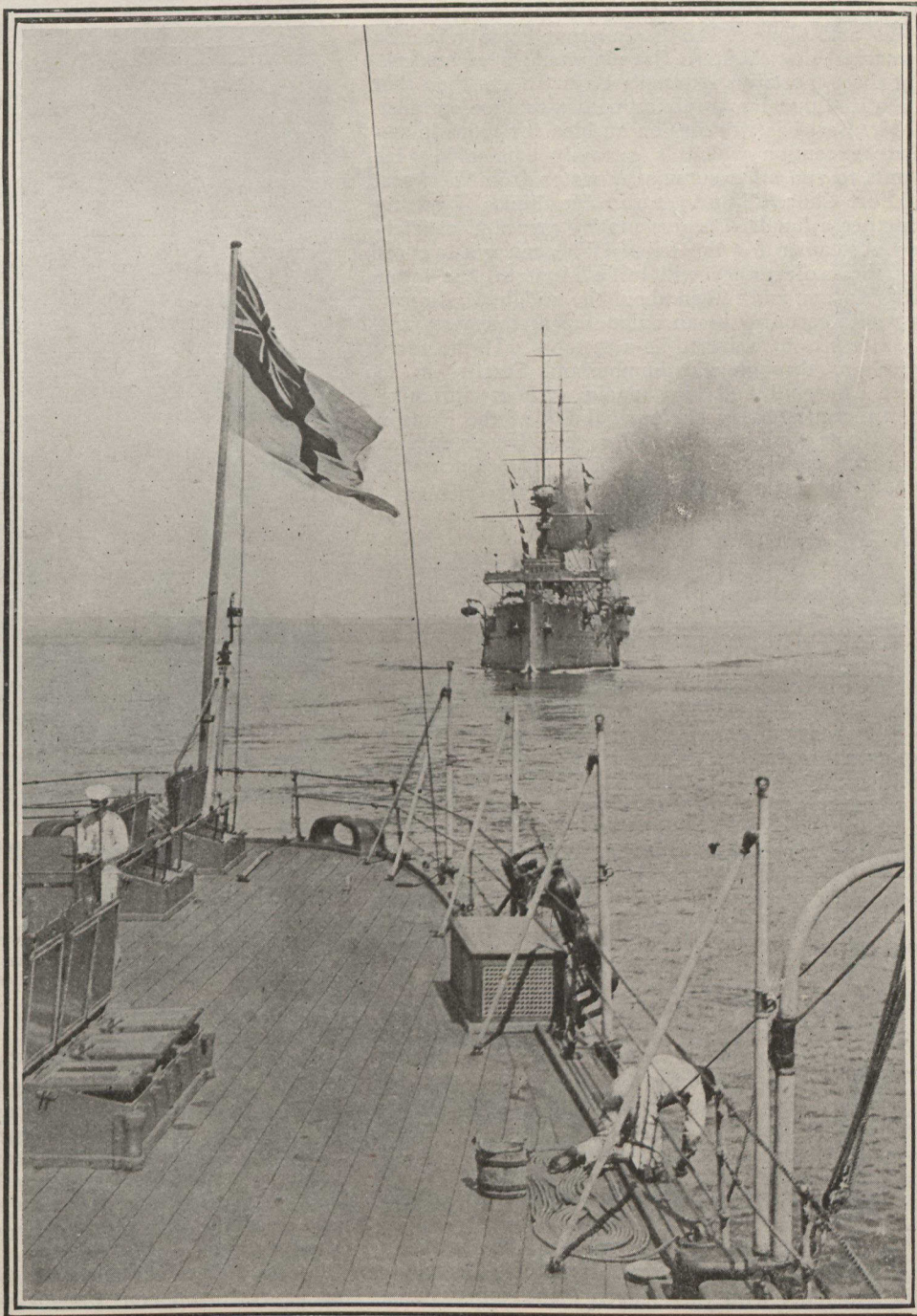
A recent picture of Bonar Law, M.P. the Canadian born British statesman.
