The matter will be carried further within a day or two. I fully realize the importance which you place upon this action on my part, and heartily agree with your view. Before acting, however, I must be sure that the possible danger of loss of influence and checking of the gratifying trend toward representation which has been developed in the last few months does not outweigh what would be gained by writing the letter.
