The Inspector from Missouri reported to the Convention on the following year that there was very little known of the Smelting System in his state, two years later one of the inspectors from Ohio stated that the Smelting System had crowded itself into the larger cities of that state, that there was considerable of it in Cleveland and that he was informed it had been engaged in much more extensively in Cincinnati, but there was evidently something of a mistake in his remarks for another member of the Convention stated that had been a resident and workman for many years in that city, the largest in the state, and of such things were they had not come under his observation.
