Sir,-

With reference to your letter of the 6th March last (296-8) I beg to enclose herewith a blue print copy of the sketch received from the Department of the Interior, showing the land desired as an addition to the Musquean and Langley Indian Reserve at New Westminster.

It appears that it is necessary to provide a road way thirty links wide to allow access from the property of Mr. T.W. Herring to the bridge. For this purpose the small triangle shown on the plan at the Easterly end of the Reserve will require to be taken. The Department is disposed to allow this piece of land to be used for the said purpose; kindly inform me if there is any objection to this proceeding.

When the matter of the said road-way is arranged steps will be taken to add to the Reserve the tract of land lying between the said road-way and the South-eastern boundary of the reserve.
