Sir:-

With reference to your return of Government property on hand on the 31st March last, I have to request that you will inform the Department of the actual number of bulls at your Agency on that date. You should also state definitely the value of each animal. The return which you submitted on the 31st March, 1910, shows that you had on hand at that time, four bulls valued ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~ at \$100.00. The return which you submitted for the 31st March, 1911, shows the receipt during the year of two bulls. It also shows that two animals were issued during the year, while the column headed "On hand 31st March" is left blank. It is necessary that you should furnish full explanations in connection with this matter, and in future you should be careful to properly prepare your returns.
