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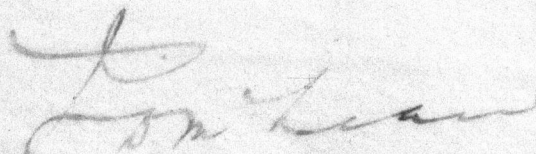
Ottawa, 12th August, 1913-

In further reply to your letter of the 28th Ultimo, about your claim for 15 cords of pulpwood cut in trespass on Lot 14, Road Range East, I have to state that you were not the Locatee of this Lot when the wood was cut in trespass while operating on the adjoining Lot through no line being visible.

You have therefore, no legal claim to the wood, which the Agent should have seized, and he will be instructed to take possession of it at once in the interest of the Band.
