There appears to be, among those who have seen the tablet, but one opinion as to its beauty, both in wording, design, and workmanship, and that is that it would be difficult, if not impossible, to improve it in any of these particulars.

Could you arrange with the photographer to send me three copies of the photo he has taken. If there are photos of different sizes, perhaps he would send one of each size, but there is no need for any of them being mounted. Would you also ask the photographer if it would be possible to have a few copies printed off on a card about the size of a post card, and if so what the cost per dozen of these would be. I shall much appreciate any attention you may give this request.
