Andrew King - died in 1865

Alexander - born East Aberdeen 1839 died 1916 in California  
left for Calif. of Aberdeen

visited Mrs. Wainwright in 1908 with his wife Olga

Olga - had a large family (one Olga married Mr. Wainwright)

Mother of Jean Gray was Helen or Nellie Black.

Mother of Helen Black was Margaret Bruce, both of Aberdeenshire.

Andrew King died in 1865.

He had several brothers, one named Hay King, who came to the southern states in early 1800's.

A brother, named Alexander, married a sister of Jean Gray.

King  
Hay, being an uncommon name, might have been an abbreviation, or nickname, so often used in East Aberdeenshire  
Alexander becomes Sandy, Alick, Alex, Aikie, or Aiken, etc.  
Grandmother King said he came to America.
