- Q.220 Was it swollen?
- I don't know. I didn't look at his case history. I know we didn't strap it or treat it.

PROSECUTOR DECLINES TO RE-EXAMINE

. QUESTIONED BY THE COURT

- Q.221 Do you know the contents of D.G.M.S. Circular Letter No.75 of 1940?
- I have read them over and the part that we are interested in here is \$2.50 a day when an officer or man is in hospital.
- Can you give any indication when it is \$3.00 and when it is \$2.50? Q.222
- The latest information is that it is to be \$3.00. There is a letter dated 13 June this year. A.
- Q.223 I understand the man was 42 days in hospital. tell me why he was 42 days in hospital?
- We keep them there until we can return them to duty. That is, when we felt we could return him to duty.

In the opinion of the Court it is not necessary to comply with R.P. 83(B).

The witness withdraws.

The prosecution has no further witnesses.
