I am in receipt of your letter of January 28th regarding a shipment of dried salmon from Vancouver.

If the shipment to you is sent in four boxes - similar to the one sent here - may I suggest that the distribution be made as follows:-

1 box to Hudson's Bay Co., Fort Babine,
1 " " " " " " Old Fort,
1 " " Mrs. Maclean, Moricetown,
50# " Daniel Leon, Topley Landing,
50# distributed amongst the Smithers and Telkwa
Indians.

I will notify the Hudson's Bay Co., Mrs Maclean and Daniel Leon regarding the distribution of the fish and shall be glad if you will advise this office what re-action takes place amongst the Indians you meet.

The shipment to Hazelton will be distributed amongst the Skeena River Indians and at Hagwilget.
