relating to acreage supports the contentions of the members, and as this is a very important matter, and does not only relate to that portion of land in dispute but affects, the jurisdiction of street ends, foreshores and other accompaning results.

The reserve refferred to at English Bay, from what I can understand was surveyed for the Indians by a man married to an Indian woman of the tribe who was the Government surveyor, but as I have not the means to fully investigate this matter of records, I recommend that the Dept. investigate this matter for the benifit of the Indians.

I will deal with the reserve at New Westminster in a special report for that reserve.

I recommend that the 130 acres at the Capilano reserve recommended by the Commission to be CUT OFF be NOT CUT OFF.

I recommend that the Squamish tribe be now given full compensation for the Kitsilano reserve, at the value of the reserve when the Indians were driven from said reserve, and in the mean time the Squamish tribe be allowed to settle on the Kitsilano reserve.

I recommend that the Provincial laws relating to inland waters, and logs drifting down the rivers be amended to allow the Indians to use or sell those trees that have washed away from Indian reserves.

The other matters are related matters to the general demands of the tribes of B.C. and will be dealt with at the time set for same.
