

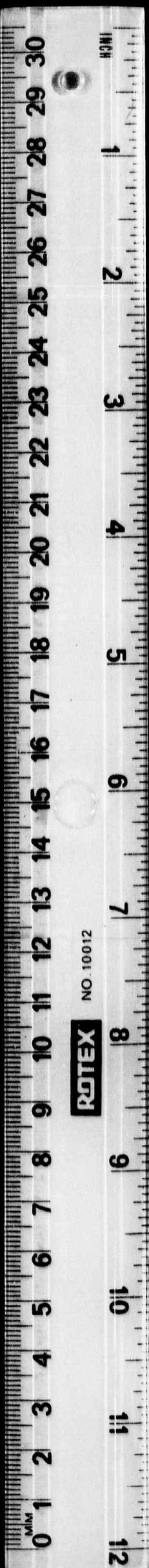
the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred

made by said Thomas Smith in folio 373 of said
Book, and which is in the following words: "This
" Register was sent down to Quebec by order of the
" Commander in Chief in the year 1784, where it re-
" mained until the year 1789 - when it was brought
" up from thence by William Oummer Powell Esq
" first Judge of his Majesty's Court of Common
" Pleas for this District of Stepe, and afterwards
" deposited in my Office in the year 1790, in the
" Month of May - and is now continued -
" During the Interval the Records of the District
" were in the hands of William Monforton who acted
" as Notary Public - to which a reference must be had.
