

CONSTITUTION

OF THE

SONS OF ENGLAND BENEFIT SOCIETY

(All previous issues are hereby repealed.)

This Society is incorporated under the provisions of the Statutes of the Province of Ontario.

NAME AND OBJECTS OF THE SOCIETY.

1. This Society shall be known as the "Sons of England Benefit Society," and have for its objects:—

(1) The bringing together of Englishmen and their male descendants for their mutual benefit and support, and the maintenance of the British Connection.

(2) The raising of funds by entrance fees, dues, beneficiary assessments, fines, donations, and interest on capital, for the following purposes: Rendering assistance to members when sick or unable to follow their employment, supplying medical attendance and medicine to members, insuring the lives of members, assisting in defraying the funeral expenses of deceased
