Now, here I must bring to light a passage of Scripture which is baffling sin-fettered Christendom and all its preachers. The Scripture is "BAPTIZED FOR THE DEAD" (I. Corinthians xv. 29). It is this Scripture which proves up to the hilt the great importance of being baptized with the Holy Ghost, sealed unto the day of redemption ("Baptized for the dead"). The answer the present-day preacher gives to prove the above is that it was a custom of the Jews, if anyone should die who had not been baptized, someone had to be baptized for him.
