

country is generally level or rolling, and the timber a mixture of hard wood and pine. From the crop of 1849 were produced 20,000 bushels of wheat, 21,000 bushels of potatoes, 11,000 lbs. of maple sugar, 4000 lbs. of wool, and 2900 lbs. of butter. Below we give agricultural returns from last census :
