## CAP. XXXVII.

An Act in Addition to and in Amendment of an Act, intituled An Act to repeal an Act, intituled, An Act for the better Security of the Navigation of certain Harbours in the County of Northumberland, and to make more effectual Provision for the better Security of the Harbours in the Counties of Northumberland, Kent and Gloucester.

Passed 19th March 1833.

'WHEREAS by the Law now in Force for Preamble. 'the Security of the Navigation of the Harbours 'and Rivers in the Counties of Northumberland, 'Kent and Gloucester, the Number of Commis-'sioners of Buoys and Beacons to be appointed to 'any One Port or Harbour in the said Counties 'respectively is not limited: And Whereas there 'is no Provision in the said Laws requiring the 'Commissioners of Beacons and Buoys in the said 'Counties to give Security for the faithful Dis-'charge of their Duty, and the due Application of the Monies coming into their Hands by virtue of their said Office: And Whereas there is no 'Provision by the said Laws for regulating the 'Time of putting down and taking up the Buoys ' and Beacons in the respective Harbours and Rivers in the said Counties, at the opening and 'shutting up of the Navigation; for Remedy "whereof."

I. Be it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Council and Assembly, That the Second Section of an Act made and passed in the Tenth and 10 & 11 G. 4, Eleventh Years of the Reign of His late Majesty c. 16, s. 2, re-King George the Fourth, intituled An Act to repeal an Act, intituled, An Act for the better Security of the Navigation of certain Harbours in the County of Northumberland, and to make more effectual Provision for the better Security of the Harbours in the Counties of Northumberland, Kent and Gloucester, be and the same is hereby repealed.
