

Household Recipes

Salmon Bisque

Drain the oil from one-third of a can of salmon, remove bone and skin, rub through a sieve, add slow-ly one quart of scalded milk, one-third teaspoon of salt and a little pepper. Rub to a paste four table-spoons of flour with two of butter. spoons of flour with two of butter. Add a tablespoon of the hot milk to the butter and flour paste, and when it is smooth add the paste to the milk. Boil up just a minute, serve piping hot. Crab meat on lobster may be used in the same way.
