

PARIS, May 1.—Two foreign diplomatic attaches in Paris yesterday accused a man as a means to end their troubles. One of them succeeded in killing himself, and the life of the other is endangered. Worry over personal affairs is said to have been the motive in both cases.

Melchyslaw Pochenow, an attaché of the Polish legation, shot and killed himself in the Champs Elysees, while a short distance away Guillermo Erazuriz junior, secretary to the Chilean legation, fired a bullet from a revolver into his temple. Erazuriz was removed to a hospital in a precarious condition.

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
