gine I am giving you only my own conjectures, take the following extract from a letter of father Noel de Joinville, of a pretty antient date.

"I have remarked in this country fo " great an aversion in the convert-savages " to the English, caused by difference of " religion, that these scarce dare inhabit " any part of Acadia but what is under " their own guns. These savages are so " zealous for the Roman Catholick " church, that they always look with " horror upon, and confider as enemies " those who are not within the pale of it. "This may ferve to prove, that if there " had been priests provided in time, to " work at the conversion of the favages " of New-England, before the English " had penetrated into the interior of the " county as far as they have done, it " would not have been possible for them " to appropriate to themselves such an " extent of country as, at this day, " makes of New-England alone the most"
