I have the honour to refer to the Agreement for Air Services between Canada and Ireland signed at Dublin on May 2, 1947.

In connection with Article 2 of the Annex to this Agreement, my understanding of my Government that Trans-Canada Airlines (Limited), as well as scheduling of flights, will also have the right to divert other flights occasionally for reasons to land at Shannon Airport.
