It was generally agreed that it should be elaborated in an annex containing: "I. Technical procedures for systematic and challenge on-site inspections

- Rights and functions of the inspectors
- Rights and functions of the host-State personnel
- General kinds of inspection procedures
- General kinds of equipment to be utilized in the inspections and who provides it.

## For further consideration:

- Sources of inspection personnel.
- "II. <u>General framework for the activities to be carried out during the</u> inspections to be performed, e.g.
  - for the regular monitoring of the destruction of CW stockpiles
  - for the regular monitoring of the single facility for small-scale production of super-toxic lethal chemicals
  - in the course of fact-finding procedures."

Note: The elements listed above could be separated in two different annexes depending on the final decision to be taken with regard to the general structure of the Convention.
