In its current form, the C/5 document is presented in three sections: the first one includes for each major programme and cross-cutting project strategies, expected results and resources earmarked, as well as details of administrative and support services, submitted for decision to the General Conference; the second section contains the appendices, which provide budgetary details in summary form; the third provides, for information, technical details on possible ways and means of implementing the activities envisaged in this context.

Do you have any suggestion as to the presentation of the programme and budget? Further, do you have suggestions concerning the content and presentation of technical details in documents 31 C/5 (Draft) and 31 C/5 Approved?

Does document 31 C/5, in general, contain too much/too little information? About right? What should be added/cut/dropped?

IV. Adjustments in medium-term programming

23. The Medium-Term Strategy has been conceived as a rolling strategy, capable of revision by the General Conference, if so required, so as to reflect:

- major developments in the international and regional contexts pertaining to UNESCO's fields of competence;
- input obtained through consultation and in-country assessments undertaken by clusters and field offices in the context of the decentralization process;
- the results achieved and outcomes of the Organization's action, also drawing on the findings of evaluations; and
- the emergence of critical issues on factors that could significantly influence the attainment of the expected outcomes.

Drawing on your above observations, do you consider that (some of) the proposals made could or should lead to major shift in emphasis in one or more of the strategic objectives or approaches formulated in document 31 C/4 and by implication for document 32 C/5? If so, what would be these modifications? In what domain(s)?
