By the end of 1961, Canada had established formal dipinelations with all the republics in Latin America. This, of included, and still includes, Cuba. This process started with establishment of missions in Argentina and Brazil early in 1975 there was a commercial representative in Buenos Aires even by 1900 and trade commissioners in several of the major capitals before the First World War. There are now 14 resident diplomissions, apart from the three offices in the Commonwealth Canada and Ca

Also in 1961, Canada became a full member of the United Nations Economic Commission for Latin America, following a perfect of observer status. This, of course, is one of the four Region Economic Commissions of the United Nations. Since then, Canadas regularly attended its meetings at its headquarters in Stand has gone to its major conferences elsewhere.

Some inter-American conferences are convened on a non-basis and have been attended by Canada.
