PRAYERS.

Nine petitions for Private Bills were presented in accordance with Standing Order 70(1).

Mr. Howard, seconded by Mr. Barnett, by leave of the House, introduced Bill C-67, An Act respecting the Canada Court of Indian Claims, which was read the first time and ordered for a second reading at the next sitting of the House.

The House resolved itself into Committee of Supply, and progress having been made and reported, the Committee obtained leave to sit again at the next sitting of the House.
