3. Mr. Ken Robinson, Liberal Member for Etobicoke-Lakeshore, requested information on the activities of Unicef relating to its fund-raising activities and its presence in Kampuchea (Cambodia).

The amount of money raised by Unicef at Hallowe'en is still being counted and the final figure is expected in January.

Last year \$1,300,000 was collected and it is estimated that at least the equivalent will be raised this year.

Between 92 and 93% of this money is used for projects for children in developing countries. Over one million

Canadian children raised this money. It is a unique program unequaled in scope or interest by any other country. The NGO Division of CIDA matches this money dollar for dollar. The Hallowe'en collection as such was not slated for Cambodia. It is an annual event for all children.

Attached for your information is a list of voluntary agencies' assistance for Kampuchea.
