1. In the fiscal year 1971-72, what were the purposes of the trips made by V. L. Chapin, Vice-President of Export Development Corporation (salary range: \$26,000-\$32,500), to (a) Royan, Paris (\$1,076) (b) Washington (\$575) (c) Paris, Rome, Athens, U.K. (\$1,560) (d) New York (\$245) (e) Mexico (\$700) (f) Paris (\$1,493) (g) London, Madrid, Athens, Rabat (\$1,501) (h) London, Tel Aviv (\$1,902)?

2. In what months of the year were these trips made?

**Mr. Herb Breau (Parliamentary Secretary to Minister of Industry, Trade and Commerce):** Export Development Corporation states that: 1. In the fiscal year 1971-72, V. L. Chapin, Vice President, made trips to (a) Royan, via Paris, to attend a course of French language; (b) Washington, as Canadian delegate to the Annual Meeting of the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development and the International Monetary Fund; (c) Paris, for financing negotiations regarding a sale of ships to France, and the United Kingdom, for international banking discussions; he did not travel to Rome and Athens on this occasion, although he had planned to do so and received a refundable travel advance for the purpose; thus a reference to Rome and Athens in the answer to question 928 was erroneous; (d) New York, for discussions with banks and investment houses; (e) Mexico, for negotiations with the Comision Federal de Electricidad, Nacional Financiera and private banks in Mexico regarding EDC loans; (f) Paris, as head of the Canadian delegation to the "Paris Club" meetings in connection with the Chilean debt rescheduling; (g) London, Madrid, Athens and Rabat, for discussions on financing related to the export of Canadian capital goods; and (h) London and Tel Aviv, to join the Minister of Trade and Commerce for financing talks with the government of Israel.

2. The trips mentioned in (a), (b), (c), (d) and (g) above were made in July/August, September, May, May and December, 1971, respectively; and those mentioned in (e), (f) and (h) were made in January, February and January, 1972, respectively.
