A Message was received from the Senate informing this House that the Senate had passed the following Bill to which the concurrences of this House is desired:

Bill S-12, An Act to amend the Immigration Act.— Mr. Andras (Port Arthur).

Mr. Kaplan for Mr. Trudel, from the Standing Committee on Finance, Trade and Economic Affairs, presented the Third Report of the Committee, which is as follows:

Pursuant to its Order of Reference of Friday, October 18, 1974, your Committee has considered Bill C-14, An Act to incorporate the Federal Business Development Bank and has agreed to report it with the following amendments:

Clause 18

Strike out line 11 of the English version on page 8 and substitute the following therefor:

'designated under subsection (1) is absent'

Strike out lines 15 and 16 of the English version on page 8 and substitute the following therefor:

'of Regional Economic Expansion may designate shall substitute as ex officio member'

Your Committee has agreed that the above amendments did not warrant a reprint of the Bill.
