gage to conduct yourfelf as a faithful Minister of the Gospel among them, and also, wherever Providence affords you an opportunity; keeping carefully in view, that this congregation, and the Church at large, be by your labours affisted, in the attainment of higher degrees of Christian improvement?

9. Do you promife to exemplify the excellence of Christian doctrine by the conficientious performance of the duties of a holy life, corresponding with your station in the Church, and your relations to fociety?

10. Do you declare that you are cordially attached to the civil authorities by which this Province is ruled; and do you promife, according to your flation, to give those proofs of loyalty which divine authority enjoins upon subjects towards their rulers?

11. Do you promife to fubmit yourfelf, in the Lord, to the authority of this Prefbytery, in fubordination to fuperior Courts?

And all thefe you profess to believe, and promife, through grace, to perform, as you muft answer to the Lord Jefus Christ, when he comes with all his Saints?
