treat with respect. Be that as it may, our association has objects for which nothing is required but social harmony and political independence, both of which we are in a fair way to secure. We have passed a pleasant evening, and we have reason to hope that it will prove the omen and precursor of many such evenings and of m ich besides that will make us hereafter look back with pleasure to the day on which we celebrated the laying of the first stone of the National Club.
