CHARGE.

Brothers, we are here assembled for a noble and worthy purpose. The object you will have in view in your meetings will be the elevation of human character, and the alleviation of human woes. I commit to you this Character, to be held under our wholesome laws for those purposes. You will hold and defend it with all diligence.
