TO BE RATIFIED IN JANUARY

Sincerely Desirous to Achieve Reforms Without Harsh Measure, Financial Criticism Could Not Be Allowed.

MUST HAVE ORDER AT ALL COSTS

Holding of Douma Elections Demands It, But Involves Dilemma Dark Reports From Livonia.

St. Petersburg, Dec. 18.—(Midnight.)—
The following statement of the government's position was made to the Associated Press to-night, and may be accepted as authoritative:
The government sincerely desired to introduce the new regime without having recourse to harsh measures, but it received no support trom the constitutionalists or other moderates, while the projetariat organizations, under the leadership of Socialists, continued their mad campaign in favor of armed rebellion and openly incited the army and the navy to mutiny. The climax of this campaign was reached when efforts were made to attack the credit of the country in the midst of a considerable panic.
