Pretoria, Transvaal, Jan. 8 .- An influential meeting of Burghers yesterday drafted an address for presentation to Colonial Secretary Chamberlain, and the Legislative Council, embodying the views of the leaders.

Among the recommendations are general amnesty, the maintenance of the Transvaal's pre-war regulations re-garding natives, the importation of cat-tle by the government, and their sale to the Burghers at actual cost, and the abolition of the South African

General Botha reported that \$525,000 had been collected in America and Europe for the relief of destitute Boers.


