TO ADVERTISER READERS. Paper Controller About To Order Cutting Off of Unpaid Subscriptions.

A public hearing in Ottawa last week in connection with paper conservation, the Paper Controller for Canada intimated that regulations about to be issued would include one to the effect that: Publishers of daily newspapers must cease sending their newspapers to subscribers three months in arrears unless subscribers be definitely renewed and all arrears fully paid.

The reason for this regulation of the Paper Controller is that it is the practice of some publishers to send their newspaper until ordered stopped, and this practice frequently means a failure to collect anything for subscriptions in arrears, in which case there is a virtual waste of paper. It is to prevent paper waste that the new regulation has been decided on.
